



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is made between:

- (A). Government Women Engineering College, Ajmer
- (B). Dr B R Ambedkar National Institute of Technology, Jalandhar Punjab.

Dr B R Ambedkar National Institute of Technology, Jalandhar and Government Women Engineering College, Ajmer are Govt. funded institutions in higher and technical education in the country. To promote academic and Research Co-operation, keeping in view the fact that NIT being an institute of National importance, it has to play a vital role in nurturing and supporting the State funded technical institutions, the two institutions agree to the following broad term of co-operation:

1. Within fields that are mutually acceptable, the parties intend to pursue the following general form of cooperation:
 - a. Exchange of scientific and technical information.
 - b. Exchange of students for the purpose of study and research.
 - c. Exchange of faculty for the purpose of research, teaching and discussion.
 - d. Exchange of information including, but not limited to, exchange of library material and research publication.
 - e. Joint research activities including guidance of Post Graduate and PhD students.
 - f. Joint course development and delivery.
 - g. Participation in nationally and internationally funded projects.
 - h. Jointly organizing events such as seminars, workshops, conferences and training programs.
 - i. Any other objective as agreed upon in writing by both the institutions
 - j. Assisting Government Women Engineering College, Ajmer students in campus placement.

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2. Both parties acknowledge and understand that all the financial agreements, if any, will be subject to prior written agreement and the availability of the funds for each activity/ project undertaken.
3. The MoU remains in place for the period of two years from the date of signing of the agreement.
4. No party shall have the right to use the name and logo of other party without permission.
5. The term of this MoU may be modified/amended at any time subject to mutual written agreement. Such modification/changes shall be effective from the date on which both the parties execute them in writing.
6. The MoU may be terminated by either party by giving 3 months written notice. In the event of termination, both parties shall ensure that the interests of the students working/projects under this MoU are safe guarded to the extent possible.


RESPONSIBILITIES OF PARTIES:

- i. Both parties mutually agree to identify various areas of interest and depute faculty/staff as per the requirements with their mutual consent.
- ii. The inviting institution shall meet the travelling expenditure and any honorarium/ remuneration as may be applicable.
- iii. The inviting institution shall make necessary lodging and boarding arrangements for the deputed person.
- iv. Both the institutions shall identify faculty for accomplishing the above laid down objectives.
- v. Each party shall attempt to make such faculty available as and when required.
- vi. Both the institutions shall organize regular faculty interaction/meets to promote research interactional collaboration among their faculty members. These meets may be organized for entire institute or specific to any department or school as per mutual convenience.


- vii. Every individual research collaboration will have separate agreement/terms of contract that addresses issues such as intellectual Properties (IPR), funding pattern disclosure of confidential information etc.
- viii. Either of the party to the MoU shall not disclose the information of any matter under research etc. to the third party during the term of MoU without the written consent of the other parties. In case of default, the second party shall have the right to terminate or send the notice to the party disclosing the secret information.

In the event of any dispute or difference that arises in the implementation of the MoU, such disputes shall be resolved amicably by mutual discussions by the Director/Principal of both the institution. In any case, if the dispute is not settled, the court at Jalandhar shall have sole jurisdiction to decide the matter in question. Now, based on the aforementioned promise(s) the parties put their signatures on this MoU on 16th August 2018.



